Imperialism: The Final Throes of Crisis-Ridden Capitalism and the Conflict of Predators over Global Plunder

The raging wars the world witnesses today are not the product of "political folly" or "diplomatic failure"; rather, they are the violent and inevitable expression of the general structural crisis of the capitalist system in its highest imperialist stage. As Lenin taught us, imperialism is capitalism in its parasitic and moribund stage, where monopoly blocs find no solution to overproduction and the accumulation of capital except through the "redivision of the world" by iron and fire.

I. The Nature of the Contemporary Imperialist System (Unity and Conflict of Opposites)

We reject the bourgeois narrative that reduces imperialism to a "rogue state" or the "policies of the Washington administration." Contemporary imperialism is an integrated global system dominated by **Finance Capital**. Despite secondary contradictions between traditional imperialist centers (the US and EU) and rising capitalist powers (Russia and China), they all submit to the law of capitalist accumulation and compete for raw materials, strategic corridors, and the surplus value extracted from the sweat of the global proletariat.

II. Critique of Revisionism and Dependency on "Alternative Poles"

The Palestinian Communist Party maintains that falling for the illusions of "multipolarity" within the capitalist framework is a dangerous deviation from Marxism-Leninism. Promoting capitalist Russia or others as an "ally of the oppressed" is a deception of the working class.

- **Our position is firm:** The proletariat cannot line up behind a "national" bourgeoisie or a "competing pole" that practices the same mechanisms of exploitation.
- **Multipolarity** under capitalism simply means a multiplicity of knives slaughtering the people. The real alternative is not "another capitalist pole," but the Socialist Pole and total liberation from the yoke of capital.

III. The Geography of Blood: Arenas as Headlines for Monopoly Conflict

Global events are not isolated; they are linked by a single class thread:

- **In Ukraine:** A struggle between two imperialist poles (NATO and Russia) at the expense of workers' blood.
- **In Sudan and the African Sahel:** A scramble of international thieves over gold and sovereign riches.
- **In Latin America:** Attempts to strangle liberation experiences in Cuba and Venezuela because they break monopoly hegemony.
- **Against Iran:** The feverish imperialist escalation against the Islamic Republic represents a strategic chapter in global capitalism's quest for absolute hegemony. It is an intersection of monopoly interests to control energy sources and subject Iranian oil and gas to the power of transnational corporations, alongside the geopolitical goal of liquidating the resistance and removing Iran as the major obstacle to Zionist expansion and the liquidation of the Palestinian cause.

IV. Palestine: At the Heart of the International Confrontation against Imperialism

In Palestine, we emphasize that the Zionist movement is an organic, functional tool within the global imperialist system. Our battle against the occupation is an inseparable part of the global battle against capitalism.

- **National and Social Liberation:** True national liberation cannot be achieved under the leadership of the Palestinian "comprador" bourgeoisie, which is tied to the interests of the occupation and donors.
- **Class Vision:** The liberation of Palestine passes through the alliance of workers, peasants, and revolutionary intellectuals, and is organically linked to the fall of reactionary Arab regimes.
- **Unity of National Soil:** Palestine—all of Palestine, from the river to the sea—is the historical and final homeland of the Palestinian Arab people. It is non-negotiable and indivisible.

V. Militarization and Fascism: The Ugly Face of Crisis

When markets narrow, capitalism sheds its "liberal democratic" mask to wear the garb of fascism. The frantic arms race is an attempt to vent the crisis through a "war economy," diverting class discontent toward an "external" or "national" enemy.

The Palestinian Comprador: A "Sixth Column" Serving the Zionist-Imperialist Cartel

The dilemma of national liberation lies in the existence of a parasitic bourgeois class (the comprador) that grew under the humiliating "Oslo Accords," turning into a local agent guarding global capital interests in exchange for crumbs of privilege.

1. **Organic Dependency:** The local comprador is not a productive class, but a middleman living on imports and agencies for Zionist and international companies.
 2. **Security Coordination as "Class Protection":** Security coordination is essentially a tool of class repression to control the toiling masses and prevent any revolutionary movement.
 3. **The Illusion of "State Building":** One cannot build a national economy without sovereignty over land, resources, and borders. What is called "institution building" is actually an accumulation of debt to banks (Finance Capital).

The Program of National and Democratic Struggle: Toward a Broad Popular Front

First: Politically and Organizationally (Decoupling)

1. **Toppling Oslo's Legitimacy:** Organized mass action to declare the end of the transitional phase and the fall of all security and economic agreements.
2. **Building the "Unified People's Resistance Front":** A leadership emerging from the grassroots (workers, peasants, students, refugees) as an alternative to the donor-dependent leadership.
3. **Withdrawing Recognition of the Enemy:** Redefining the struggle as a conflict of national existence.

Second: Economically (Self-Reliance Policy)

1. **Tax and Economic Civil Disobedience:** Ceasing tax payments that fund security coordination or bloated bureaucratic salaries.
2. **Nationalization of Vital Resources:** Nationalizing major companies (telecom, energy, banks) and converting them into cooperative properties managed by popular committees.
3. **Comprehensive Boycott:** Moving beyond goods to boycotting the Zionist "labor market" by creating national agricultural and industrial alternatives.

Third: Socially and Class-wise (Strengthening Resilience)

1. **Revolutionary Agrarian Reform:** Reclaiming land threatened by confiscation and granting ownership to poor peasants.

2. **Protecting Labor Rights:** Forming independent, non-domesticated unions to defend workers and enforce a fair social security law.

Fourth: Internationally (Militant Internationalism)

1. **The Axis of Resistance:** We affirm that the Palestinian Communist Party is an organic part of the **Axis of Resistance**, the front line against imperialist and Zionist hegemony.
2. **Unity of Popular Arenas:** We emphasize the fatal link between the Jordanian and Palestinian people, viewing the Jordanian masses as the strategic depth of our struggle.

Conclusion of the Program: This program is a plan for the field. We call on every comrade and free citizen to join "Popular Committees" in villages, camps, and cities to be the nucleus of alternative popular power.
